"Easy," replies Doug, "These are my khakis."

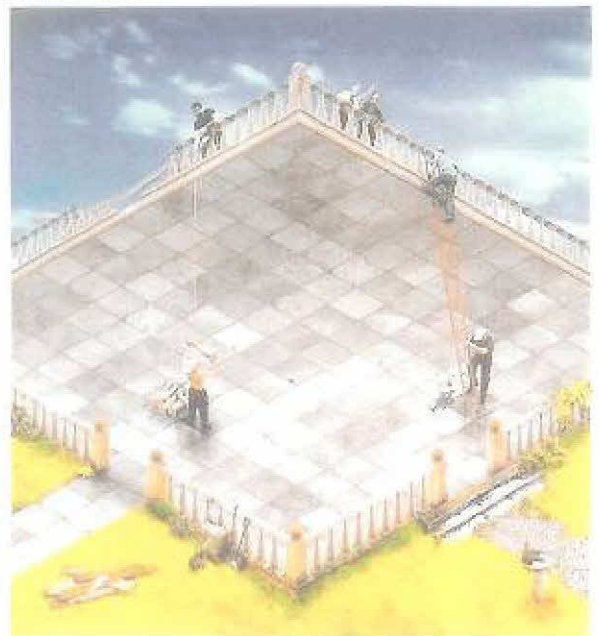
